Its title is the former phone number of the American National Suicide Prevention Lifeline which is 1-800-273-8255.

This song is sung by the American rapper, Logic, featuring Alessia Cara, a Canadian singer, and American singer, Khalid. **To give you an idea** of how emotional this song is, the first two **verses** (a section in music that tells the main story of the song) are from the **perspective** (point of view) of a person who is suicidal. He expresses his intention of

ending his life. In the third verse, he believes that no one really cares about him and that his life doesn't matter to anyone else. That itself signifies (to be a sign of something) that a person has a mental health issue and he's battling it on his own. That is actually a mirror of what has been happening in our society. As you know, a lot of people end their lives because of depression. Those who committed suicide believed that it was the best thing that they could do to get away (escape) from the pain in this world. It's sad because they could've been saved if we had eradicated (to get rid of something completely) the stigma (shame) of mental illness. (grammar: the use of a conditional statement)

Actually, this song was released in 2017 and I only discovered this song during the **height** (the most intense part) of the pandemic because this song **blew up** (to become widely popular) on Youtube. I think that's because a lot of people got depressed during those difficult times and I believe Youtube pushed this song to a lot of audiences to remind them that if they're suffering from mental health issues, they could call 1-800-273-8255, which is also the title of the song.

Anyway, the remaining verses of the song express hope. The singer encourages a suicidal person to keep living because life gets better.
